Healthy Packed Lunches @Bugthorpe @Sutton

Although it's nice to have a treat in your packed lunches, it is very important to have a healthy, balanced lunch in order to provide your children with energy and nutrients to keep them going throughout the school day.

Lunchbox Top Tips

- Fuller for longer make sure to include carbohydrates in your backed lunches. Foods like wholegrain bread, rice, pasta and potatoes will help keep your children fuller for longer.
- Ever green try to add salad to your sandwiches and wraps too this will count to your child's 5 a day!
- Switch the sweets try swapping cakes, chocolate and biscuits for malt loaf, fruit breads or fresh, dried or tinned fruit.
- Always add veg cherry tomatoes, sticks of cucumber, carrots or celery all count towards your 5 a day.
