Dear Parents and Guardians,



#### Hagg Bridge Closure @Sutton

The bridge on Hagg Lane will be closed from 6<sup>th</sup> January until 31<sup>st</sup> August 2020. We realise the significance of this for some parents and hope you manage to find alternative routes to get to school.



#### Launch of Team Points @Sutton

We have launched team points at Sutton! The whole school (including nursery) have been divided into 4 teams - Badgers, Squirrels, Owls and Hedgehogs. Children are given team points for behaviour, hard work, attitude, manners and effort. When a child gets to 10 team points they receive a Rose Globe stamp. When they get to 20 Rose Globe stamps they receive a bronze rose badge to wear with pride on their school uniform. As they progress through school they will work towards their silver and gold rose badges! The Vice Captains will also collect the running totals of the team points in each class (each week) and the team with the most team points (in a week) will win a tally on the graph. The team with the most wins in a term will receive a team prize! We will ask 'Pupil Voice' for their opinions of team prizes but examples from the past include DVDs, extra sports, extended playtime or craft activities etc.

We will also be holding Team Challenge Days where the children will move around sessions (run by the teachers) in their teams. Bugthorpe just held an RE Team Challenge Day (pictures on their Facebook page). Our first main one will be in the spring term and I can't wait to get this planned.
