## Transition 2020 @Sutton @Bugthorpe

Children will be joining their new class teacher within Tapestry (EYFS) and Seesaw (Year 1-6) next week. All children will be moved up a year, for example, if they are currently in Reception (using Tapestry) they will be moved up to Year 1 (using Seesaw). Log in details will be shared for you to sign up. The class teachers will share some transition/'getting to know you' tasks for your children to have a go at and upload.

Next week's Zoom meetings on Wednesday 15<sup>th</sup> July will be set up for the children to meet their new teacher and class mates. A new link will be emailed out. Children in school will be able to join these using Ipads where possible (if not they will meet their new teacher in person, socially distanced).

## Returning to School in September @Sutton @Bugthorpe

All pupils are welcomed back to school in September; attendance returns to mandatory nationally. Unfortunately, the guidance still suggests that parents are only allowed on site with an appointment so our current drop off and pick up routines will resume. This also means that we will not be able to host any assemblies, where parents are invited, until further notice. We do see the return of our Breakfast and Afterschool Clubs, which will run as normal – more details regarding drop off and collection at clubs will be in the 'Return to School Plan' that will be emailed out this week and available on our school websites. Staff are able to move between class bubbles so we will return to a full week of education (Monday -Friday). In case of a localised lockdown, we would return to home learning via Tapestry (EYFS) and Seesaw (Years 1-6).

I, personally, will be able to move between schools again so will continue my routine of Mondays and Wednesdays at Bugthorpe, Tuesdays and Thursdays at Sutton and alternate Fridays (Week 1 of Autumn term, I will be at Sutton on the Friday).
