production line). We are actively seeking grants from the National Lottery to further develop our school grounds, with the hope of inviting members of the community into school to work with the children in the allotment; we also aim to improve our chicken run. Research suggests, being outside and working together for a common goal, benefits everyone's mental health and wellbeing. Any profits we make from our 'market stall' will go towards our selected school charities.
