

Farewell Mr Tanikal as Chair of Governors @Bugthorpe

Huge thanks and best wishes from everyone involved with school, goes to Mr Tanikal, who steps down from the role of Chair of Governors (as his youngest is set to leave Year 6). Mr Tanikal has guided us, with strong leadership, through the storm and I personally would like to thank him for all his support in my first years of Headship. Mrs Ross, steps up to lead the school going forward, as we moved towards one governing body across the two schools.

In his letter of resignation, Mr Tanikal wrote:

Now that you and the team have shown how well we can adapt to any challenges and provide the excellent provision for the children, I feel it is the right time for me to leave. I know that in you and Mrs Ross, I leave the school in safe hands and in far better shape than when I started.

I just wanted to make it clear to you, the staff, parents and children that my decision is in no way any reflection on the decision to federate. I have as you know been a supporter of this move and had the timetable for federation been what we hoped, it would have nicely tied in with my leaving, however, that was not to be. I do believe it will be the best thing for both schools going forward and with strong leadership from you and Mrs Ross, the Governors of the federation will be in a good place to push on to achieve that outstanding from Ofsted, that we all know we can achieve.

I would like to thank governors, staff, parents and pupils, both past and present, for helping me along the way. It's been very hard, but also enjoyable.

While I didn't quite get my goal of outstanding for the school during my time, I am more convinced than ever, that with this team it is only a matter of time. Irrespective of that, I know that we give the children a well-rounded and excellent education.

I am sure you will join me in wishing Mr Tanikal, and his family, all the very best for the future.
