Pupil Voice Conference @Bugthorpe @Sutton

What is a Pupil Voice Conference and how does it work in our schools?

Pupil Voice Conferences happen at the end of a half term. They are a forum where the pupils can get their views across about selected topics, developing their courageous advocacy. The week before, in Collective Worship, the Headteacher will discuss the up-and-coming conference and promote some topics, which may come up for debate; pupils will also be able to put forward topics for discussion too.

In the week of the Pupil Voice Conference, each teacher will be given a topic to discuss e.g. school meals – how can we improve our healthy eating? They will spend 10 minutes in each classroom to gather 'pupil voice'. After 40 minutes, each class will have been visited by all of the teachers and will have discussed all of the topics.

The teachers will collate their evidence and report their findings to the Headteacher. The Headteacher will analyse the results of the Pupil Voice Conference and work with the staff team to put any actions in place for the following half term. The Headteacher will share with results with the pupils in Collective Worship and with parents and other stakeholders in the next available newsletter.
